### **Beginning Folk Guitar 2**

**Dates:** October 30 - December 18 (7 weeks)

**Instructor:** Libby Wiebel

**Objective:** Students will continue to learn to play fun American folk songs on the acoustical guitar in a small group setting! Each week kids will enjoy learning basic chords and strumming patterns for familiar songs chosen primarily, but not exclusively, from the rich canon of American folk music. Also included will be a selection of children's nursery songs, as these are short, familiar, and easily learned. New chords and new songs will be added each week as students also learn to read music and basic music theory.

Students should have completed Beginning Folk Guitar 1 or equivalent. Students should be able to read at grade level for this class, and should plan to practice at home each week.

2	Discuss chord families which chords belong together. Apply the Roman Numerals we discussed in week 6.

3	Perform a simple transposition of a song using chord families.
