Unit 1: Welcome to the Deaf World!

Basic ASL signs, numbers, fingerspelling, and sentences as well as the culture of Deaf people are introduced!

Unit 2: Academics

Immerse into school-related signs, types of schools, classroom-related objects and actions, academic degrees, majors, and minors!

Unit 3: Family and Relationships

Describe appearances, discuss families, friends, pets, employment status, milestones, and life events.

Unit 4: Residences and Communities

Explore transportation, housing, dwellings, places around town, neighborhoods, cities, states, and provinces.

Unit 5: Scheduling

Stay on top of things with calendars, time, events, errands, reasons, excuses, frequency, and daily routines.

Unit 6: Good Times

Romp with opinions and insights about varying skill levels, hobbies and interests, sports and recreation, vacations, and snack time!

Unit 7: All About Food!

Chow down signs about fruits, vegetables, meat, poultry, seafood, sweets, different cuisines, and recipes.

Unit 8: People Among Us
